Subject:-Grant of Yearly Permission to Indian Institute of Ayurvedic Medicine & Research, Lingadeeragollahalli, Kundana, Hobli, near Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru- 562110, Karnataka (Inst. ID-AYU0068) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 reg.

Sir/Madam,

- 1) I am to refer to your application/scheme vide ref no. **IIAMR/ACA/2023-24/248** dated **28.07.2023** in the direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order dated **30.03.2022** in MFA no. **4393/2015** passed by the High Court of Karnataka at Bengaluru on the subject for relocation of your college and to verify the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff and other facilities available at your college namely Indian Institute of Ayurvedic Medicine & Research(Inst. ID-AYU0068), your college was visited on **07.08.2025 & 08.07.2025** in hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to process the permission with **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course** and relocation of your college to new campus at **Lingadeeragollahalli, Kundana, Hobli, near Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru- 562110, Karnataka** from old campus at **Bangalore Palace Compound, Jayamahar Road, J.C Nagar, Bangalore - 56006, Karnataka** under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 from the academic session 2025-26.
- 2) Further, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine issued a **Letter of Intent (LoI)** of even number dated **22.07.2025** to your college regarding relocation of the college from old campus at **Bangalore Palace Compound, Jayamahar Road, J.C Nagar, Bangalore - 56006, Karnataka** to new campus at **Lingadeeragollahalli, Kundana, Hobli, near Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru - 562110, Karnataka**, under section 29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder from the academic session 2025-26.
- 3) Therefore, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely Chapter VIII "**Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024**" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and also in accordance with the **Standard Operating Procedure for relocation as per change in site/ location for a fully established ASUS Colleges placed in 64th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM held on 11.10.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-**

I. Teaching staffs:-

For UG Course:-

Availability of total teaching staff for UG(BAMS) course after clarification submitted by the college is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{27}{30} \times 100\% = 90\%$ (Excluding Excess)

- 4) Further, an opportunity of clarification vide letter of even no. dated 20.08.2025 was issued to you. In response of the same you have submitted the clarification vide ref no. IIAMR/ACA/2025-26/280 dated 22.08.2025. The submitted documents were verified & found complying.
- 5) The assessment report along with clarification was duly placed in the **143rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 26.08.2025** and Board observed that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the concerned acts and regulations. Further, the Board also observed that the college is not fulfilling the criteria for extended permission in accordance with regulation 54(2) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 as the college was issued Denial of Conditional Permission for the academic session 2024-25. Hence, the Board decided to issue Yearly Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with regulation 54 (3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26 in accordance of Chapter VIII "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and approved the application/scheme of relocation of the college from old campus at Bangalore Palace Compound, Jayamahar Road, J.C Nagar, Bangalore - 56006, Karnataka to new campus at Lingadeeragollahalli, Kundana, Hobli, near Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru - 562110, Karnataka in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedure for relocation as per change in site/ location.

"DECISION"

- 6) Therefore, to Indian Institute of Ayurvedic Medicine & Research, Lingadeeragollahalli, Kundana, Hobli, near Kempegowda International Airport, Devanahalli Taluk, Bengaluru-562110, Karnataka (Inst. ID-AYU0068) is hereby granted with, Yearly Permission with an intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course in accordance with Regulation 54

(3) of Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda colleges 2024 for the academic session 2025-26, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcoming shall be fulfilled along with the following condition:-

- I. It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted there under.**
- II. It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 7) Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.
- 8) Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
- 9) Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10) **You are hereby instructed to comply with all the requirements of Aadhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System as mentioned in the Implementation letters vide.ref. no. 3/2024/MARB/AEBAS & HMS. Dated 09.05.2024 & 06.09.2024 issued by the Board.**
- 11) **The following requirements must be fulfilled and the compliance report must reach the Board by 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made there under should be fulfilled.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in Para no. 4 above, shall be fulfilled.
 - v) **The applicant shall fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria for teaching hospital as per of Chapter IV of "Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024"**
- 12) The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
